RE: Flash EOL Support Announcement

As you may be aware, Adobe announced in July 2017 that they will stop distributing and updating Flash Player after December 31, 2020 ("EOL Date").

Adobe made this announcement in collaboration with several of its technology partners – including Apple, Facebook, Google, Microsoft and Mozilla – which issued complementary announcements with more technical detail on what the Flash Player EOL will mean for developers, enterprises, and consumers using their specific OS environments or browsers.

Following this announcement Archibus will be ending the support and sales of all Flash-based product views by the EOL Date.

What does this mean for your Archibus applications?

- In v23.1, all out-of-the-box chart, drawing and calendar views, still use Flash-based components.
- In v23.2, the majority of chart controls, as well as the drawing control, were replaced with HTML5 equivalents. Gantt Chart and Calendar views still rely on Flash-based controls.
- In v24.1, all remaining control types were replaced with HTML5 equivalents and Flash-based components are no longer used anywhere in the out-of-the-box product.

To ensure Client business continuity we recommend that existing Clients on Archibus v23, or prior, upgrade to the latest version.
